### Masters Scholarship Programme

The Masters Scholarship is a way to help teachers of religion and worldviews (RE) to take a relevant part-time Masters course at a reduced cost. There are a limited number of scholarship places allocated each year.

### Personal Professional Development Grants

These grants are specifically for personal professional development which supports our vision of excellence in religion and worldviews (e.g. MA, PhD). They are usually awarded to serving teachers or those working within the field of religion and worldviews such as advisers or early career researchers.

### Small Scale Project Funding

Small-Scale grants are typically awarded for new innovative projects or seed-corn funding which support the Trust's vision and strategic goals. The maximum amount for which applicants can apply is £5K. We welcome applications from individuals and groups of teachers as well as charities, organisations and corporate bodies.
