Initial evaluation positive Thanks to Culham!

Pupils' understanding of diversity within worldviews has broadened and they are less likely to talk about worldviews using generalisations or stereotypes

"[My class] learnt to accept others and be empathetic to others in their situations"

85% of pupils felt they gained something positive from the research element

Using drama/narrative has made pupils feel more comfortable engaging with unfamiliar worldviews
